The Archive Store has been kept in reasonable order through the hard work and stalwart efforts of members of the Management Committee. Especial mention must be made of our Secretary, Jean Poulter, who has put much time and effort into reorganising the contents. Over the past year several books have been kindly donated to our archives.

The current lease of our Archive Store will expire in August 2021. Currently, Wokingham Borough Council is negotiating with the Polehampton Charity over terms of a lease and have agreed in principle to provide archival space for the Local History Society in the Old Boys School building.

Several successful exhibitions, held in the local library and organised by members of the Management Committee, have included a history of our local shops, with photographs from the archives, and the life of Lettice Curtis during WWII as a member of the Air Transport Auxiliary. Members will no doubt have enjoyed the drawings by Ron Durant in past journals, many of which are stored in the archive store, and it is hoped to create an exhibition of Ron's drawings in the near future which will, again, be held in the local library.
